The 'double loop' presumes the modification of the purposes from the perspective of the accumulated experiences during their mobility for training.
Practice/Speciality teachers will use specific Safeguarding (vulnerable groups protection) knowledge in their own formal way of teaching and they will be aware more relevant how the agreement should also include articles that refer to **the protection of vulnerable groups**, with a positive effect over their individual **collaborative working skills**.
